

Tag Shield Installation Instructions

Use Tag Shield to temporarily disable your windshield sticker tag when your RV Toll Pass is in use. This will help avoid getting charged twice for the same toll.

Tag Shield easily mounts to your interior windshield directly over the windshield sticker tag, to prevent the sticker tag from being read while using your RV Toll Pass transponder. When your RV Toll Pass is stored away in its protective mylar bag, remove the Tag Shield to enable your windshield sticker tag.

3 Easy Steps to Install Tag Shield



Use an alcohol wipe to clean the windshield to the left and right of the windshield sticker tag that is mounted to your interior windshield.

Peel off the backing from the hook-and-loop strips located on each side of Tag Shield to expose the adhesive.



Position Tag Shield so that it completely covers the windshield sticker tag. Press the sides firmly to ensure the hook-and-loop strips adhere to the windshield, ensuring that the shield fits closely against the windshield sticker tag.



Leave Tag Shield in place for 24-hours following the initial installation to allow the hook-and-loop adhesive to cure.

Keep the hook-and-loop strips that are mounted on the windshield in place for fast installation and removal of Tag Shield.

Removal Instructions



Grip Tag Shield by its upper and lower handles and pull it away from the windshield. Remember that the hook-and-loop strips that are adhered to the windshield should stay in place.

Store Tag Shield in your vehicle's console when it is not in use.
