

## **Toll Roads and Bridges Accepting RV Toll Pass By State \***

There are 127 major toll authorities in the US representing over 5000 miles of electronic-payment toll roads where RV Toll Pass will be accepted and require only one account for all usage. Of these toll roads, RV Toll Pass will presently not work on only 28 miles in two states, Louisiana and South Carolina, representing Less than 1% of the total mileage for all roads with open road tolling. Toll roads and bridges are continually being added to those participating with RV Toll Pass.

There are a few minor toll roads, tunnels and bridges across the US, listed below, that accept only cash or alternate form of payment and where RV Toll Pass will not be accepted. If you intend to use one or more of these, be aware that you will (1) need to pay at the toll booth or (2) be billed via your vehicle license plate.

### **ALABAMA (No major toll roads)**

These Alabama toll roads only accept cash or the Freedom Pass proximity card.

- Alabama River Parkway (N. Montgomery, AL) 1
- Emerald Mountain Expressway (Emerald Mountain, AL) 1
- Foley Beach Express (Gulf Shores, AL) 1
- Joe Mallisham Parkway (W. Tuscaloosa, AL) 1

### **ALASKA (No major toll roads)**

Whittier Tunnel only accepts cash or credit cards. Multiple use ticket books available.

- Whittier Tunnel EB (Whittier, AK) 1

### **CALIFORNIA**

All California toll roads accept RV Toll Pass. See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

### **COLORADO**

All Colorado toll roads allow RV Toll Pass users and charge via the vehicle license plate.

### **DELAWARE**

All Delaware toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**FLORIDA**

All Florida toll roads accept RV Toll Pass except for the following two bridges and causeways that accept cash only. See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

- Boca Grande Causeway WB (Placida, FL) 1
- Hammock Dunes Bridge EB (Palm Coast, FL) 1

**GEORGIA**

See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

**ILLINOIS**

All Illinois toll roads accept RV Toll Pass except the following cash only bridge.

- Wabash Cannonball Road (Wabash River at St. Francisville, IL) 1

**INDIANA**

All Indiana toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**IOWA**

There are no toll roads in Iowa except the following cash only bridge.

- Fort Madison Toll Bridge EB (Mississippi River at Fort Madison, IA) 1

**KANSAS**

All Kansas toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**LOUISIANA**

There is now a statewide prepaid toll system called Geauxpass, but no support for RV Tollpass. Pay at toll booth.

- Avery Island Bridge SB (Avery Island, LA) 1
- Lake Pontchartrain Causeway SB (Mandeville - Metairie, LA) 1
- Louisiana Hwy 1 SB (Port Fourchon – Leeville) 1

**MAINE**

All Maine toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**MARYLAND**

All Maryland toll roads, tunnels and bridges accept RV Toll Pass with exception of Oldtown Low Water toll bridge that accepts cash only.

- Oldtown Low Water Bridge (Potomac River at Oldtown, MD) 1

**MASSACHUSETTS**

All Massachusetts toll roads, tunnels and bridges accept RV Toll Pass.

**MICHIGAN**

The two Michigan toll bridges below accept cash, credit card or a local electronic toll collection tag that is only able to be used at the bridge for which it was purchased.

- Gross ile Toll Bridge (Detroit River) 1
- Mackinac Bridge (Straits of Mackinac) 1

**MINNESOTA**

Minnesota toll roads are accepting RV Toll Pass. However, there is no HOV support for RV's. Do not use HOV lanes.

**MISSOURI**

The following Missouri toll bridge accepts cash and cards.

- Lake of the Ozarks Bridge (Lake of the Ozarks, MO) 1

**NEBRASKA (No major toll roads)**

The Nebraska toll bridges below accept cash only.

- Bellevue Toll Bridge (Missouri River at Bellevue, NE) 1
- Plattsmouth Toll Bridge (Missouri River at Plattsmouth, NE) 1

**NEW HAMPSHIRE**

All New Hampshire toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**NEW JERSEY**

All New Jersey toll roads, tunnels and bridges accept RV Toll Pass except the bridge listed here that takes cash only.

- Downbeach Expr & Margate Bridge (Route 563, Margate City, NJ) 1

**NEW YORK**

All New York toll roads, tunnel and bridges accept RV Toll Pass except the Atlantic Beach Bridge that accepts cash or decal for residents only.

- Atlantic Beach Bridge (Route 878, Atlantic Beach, NY) 1

**NORTH CAROLINA**

All North Carolina toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**OHIO**

All Ohio toll roads accept RV Toll Pass except the cash only Newell toll bridge.

- Newell Toll Bridge (Golding Street, E. Liverpool, OH) 1

**OKLAHOMA**

All Oklahoma toll roads accept RV Toll Pass.

**OREGON (No major toll roads)**

The following two bridges are not interoperable with RV Toll Pass. Pay cash or card at booth.

- Bridge of the Gods (Cascade Locks, OR) 1
- Hood River Toll Bridge (Hood River, OR) 1

**PENNSYLVANIA**

All Pennsylvania toll roads accept RV Toll Pass except cash only Dingman’s Ferry bridge.

- Dingman’s Ferry Bridge (Route 739, Dingman’s Ferry, PA) 1

**SOUTH CAROLINA**

South Carolina toll roads accept RV Toll Pass 1

**TEXAS**

All Texas toll roads, tunnels and bridges accept RV Toll Pass except the Bluewater Hwy Bridge which accepts cash/cc only.

- Bluewater Hwy Bridge (Galveston - San Louis Island, TX) 1

**UTAH (No major toll roads)**

Utah’s Adams Ave Parkway accepts cash or a local ExpressCard account. Stop and pay cash at the toll booth. See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

- Adams Avenue Parkway (Washington Terrace, UT) 1

**VIRGINIA**

All Virginia toll roads, tunnels and bridges accept RV Toll Pass. See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

**WASHINGTON**

All Washington toll roads allow RV Toll Pass users and charge discounted rate via the vehicle license plate. See comments on High Occupancy Toll (HOT) and Express Lanes.

- Evergreen Point Floating Bridge (Route 520, Lake Washington, WA) 2

**WEST VIRGINIA**

All West Virginia toll roads accept RV Toll Pass except cash only Memorial Bridge.

- Memorial Bridge (Ohio River at N. Parkersburg, WV) 1

## **INTERNATIONAL BRIDGES**

RV Toll Pass is not intended for travel across international bridges between the US and Mexico or the US and Canada. International bridges in the northeast that are clearly marked as accepting EZ-Pass and international bridges in Texas that are clearly marked as accepting TxTag are interoperable with RV Toll Pass.

## **GENERAL STATEMENT ON HIGH OCCUPANCY TOLL (HOT) LANES, TOLLED EXPRESS LANES**

Several States including California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Minnesota, Virginia and Washington have implemented (HOT) lanes and/or tolled express lanes. These are lanes that have been added to highways to provide optional lane(s) for travel at a cost. The lanes may be less congested than the regular traffic lanes. The cost to use these lanes is typically posted prominently and may vary by time of day or the amount of congestion in the regular traffic lanes. Local rules and regulations control what vehicles may use these lanes, special transponders and/or the number of occupants needed in the vehicle. Special discount pricing based on number of occupants may not currently be available to RV Toll Pass users. Interstate highway I-66 in Virginia at times becomes HOT only and therefore tolls cannot be avoided. It is advisable to check with local toll authorities before using these lanes.
